Influenza Vaccine

Influenza vaccine will be available to all:

 MUSTARDSEED HEALTH CARE SERVICES employees annually in the fall. A notice is sent to inform staff when the vaccine is available.

Measles Vaccine, Rubella Vaccine, Polio Vaccine

 Not generally available, but is considered on an individual basis, if at risk or in contact with infected patients.

Tetanus/Toxoid

• Is offered for work-related injuries.

O.S.H.A regulation states that all health care professionals with occupational exposure to blood borne pathogens must be offered with hepatitis B vaccinations. You have been determined to be at risk to blood borne pathogens.

I have already received the hepatitis B vaccine

I decline the hepatitis B vaccine

If interested with the hepatitis B vaccine, I may contact the Frederick or Washington County Health Department.

I understand that due to my occupational exposure to blood borne or other potentially infectious material I may be at risk of acquiring hepatitis B virus (HBV) infection.

I have been given the opportunity to be vaccinated with the hepatitis B vaccine. However I decline hepatitis B vaccination at this time.

I understand that by declining this vaccine, I continue to be at risk of acquiring hepatitis B, a serious disease.

If in the future I continue to have occupation exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials and I want to be vaccinated with hepatitis B vaccine; I can receive the vaccination series.
